COURT ORDER

ERIE COUNTY

For the efficient and safe operation of the Court, it is hereby ordered:

All persons entering and doing business in the Vermilion Municipal Court shall wear a facial covering.

The Vermilion Municipal Court will limit access to only those individuals with court business.

All persons entering the Vermilion Municipal Court may be subject to health screening, including but not limited to the taking of body temperature, persons may be denied from admission based upon the results of such screening or testing.

MASKS (FACE/NOSE) ARE REQUIRED TO BE WORN WHILE IN THE COURTHOUSE.

You will be subject to a brief SCREENING which includes your temperature being taken with a touchless, infrared thermometer prior to entering into the Courthouse,

Appropriate SOCIAL DISTANCING of 6 feet shall be practiced in all areas of the Courthouse if possible.

No individual, including but not limited to staff, attorneys', litigants, or members of the public, shall enter or remain in the Vermilion Municipal Court if any of the following apply:

- Fever within the 3 days immediately before your hearing (temperature of 100.4 or higher without the use of fever-reducing medication).
- Cough, shortness of breath/difficulty breathing.
- Chills, muscle pain.
- Sore throat.
- Loss of smell or taste.
- Vomiting or diarrhea.
- Or if you have been in direct contact with someone known or presumed to have COVID-19 within the 14 days immediately before your hearing.

Public areas will be periodically sanitized with heavy traffic areas being frequently sanitized including,
